Administered by a board of physicians who are members of the Fresno-Madera Medical Society, the goal of this scholarship program is to encourage medical students to practice in Fresno and Madera counties which have insufficient numbers of physicians to care for their citizens. To be eligible for a scholarship, you must be a resident of either Fresno or Madera County for a minimum of three years. You must be enrolled in or accepted to an accredited allopathic or osteopathic medical school. Students waiting for confirmation of acceptance to medical school may apply.
