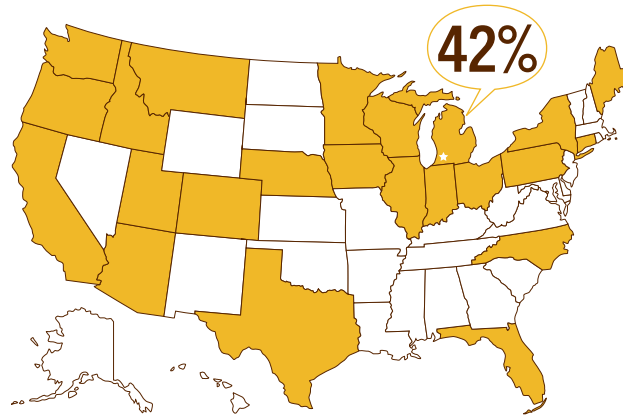

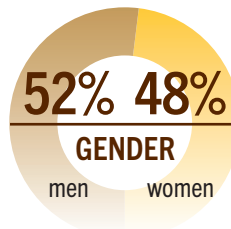

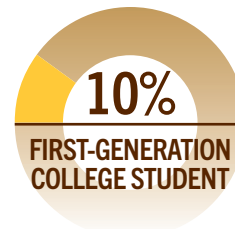
AVERAGE AGE

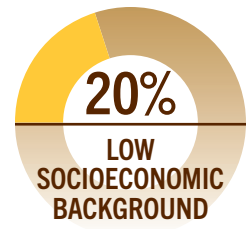
