Candidates can apply all three years of medical school regardless of whether they have been awarded previously. NBME Fee Assistance Program for USMLE Step 1 or Step 2 	Established in 2024 by the National Board of Medical Examiners (NBME), this assistance award will provide \$680 awards to 1340 medical students who have registered and taken the USMLE Step 1 or Step 2 CK exam in 2025 to offset the cost of exam registration fees. Applicants must be able to demonstrate financial need, provide a valid USMLE ID number, and have not been referred to a committee and found to have engaged in Irregular Behavior or otherwise reviewed for policy violations in relation to any USMLE or NBME exam. One year of scholarship support in exchange for a minimum of two years of full-time service. May be eligible for NHSC Loan Repayment Program (NHSC LRP) once service commitment is complete.
