Iranian-American Scholarship Fund (IASF)	Scholarships are awarded on the basis of academic excellence, financial need, and commitment to community service. Eligibility requirements include Verifiable Iranian heritage, US citizenship OR legal permanent residency with a valid permanent resident card, Enrollment as a full-time Graduate (PhDs not eligible) student in a degree-seeking program at an accredited institution in the U.S., Demonstrated need for financial assistance, and Demonstrated commitment to community service. Applicants must demonstrate their financial need by submitting their Financial Aid information, Student Aid Report, and any other appropriate financial documents for consideration.
