NHSC Students to Service Loan Repayment Program (NHSC S2S LRP) Service Commitment	If you are a student in your last year of medical, nursing, or dental school, you may be eligible to receive loan repayment assistance from the NHSC Students to Service Loan Repayment Program (NHSC S2S LRP). In return, you provide at least three years of service at an NHSC-approved site in a designated Health Professional Shortage Area (HPSA). <u>National Health Service Corps Scholarship Program (NHSC SP)</u>	The NHSC SP awards scholarships to students pursuing eligible primary care health professions training. In return, scholars commit to provide primary care health services in Health Professional Shortage Areas (HPSAs). One year of scholarship support in exchange for a minimum of two years of full-time service. May be eligible for NHSC Loan Repayment Program (NHSC LRP) once service commitment is complete.
